Director CICR & Team Visited North Cotton Growing Zone to Assess Status of Bt Cotton

Dr. K. R. Kranthi, Director, Central Institute for Cotton Research, Nagpur along with Dr. A. H. Prakash, PC and Head, CICR Regional Station Coimbatore, Dr. M. V. Venugoplan, Head ,PME cell, Dr. N. Gopalakrishnan, Dr. S. M. Palve , Dr. T.R. Loknathan and Dr. M. Sabesh visited the North cotton growing zone (Faridkot, Hisar, Sirsa) of India to assess the status of Bt cotton varieties in *G. hirsutum* and Long Staple *G. arboreum* trial from 28 September to 30 September 2016. The team started from Faridkot and reached at CICR RS, Sirsa on 29.09.2016. At CICR Sirsa, Director discussed the progress of each project and then team visited the trial laid out at CICR Sirsa and monitored the performance of the Bt cotton varieties, their plant type, bollworm and CLCuD incidence. The team also visited the trials on Long Staple *G. arboreum* cotton being conducted under AICRP on Cotton and separately planned by CICR Nagpur also.
